OUR NEW YEAR FESTIVAL FOR TREES

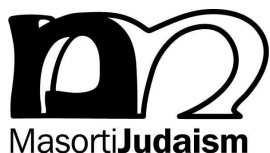
symbolic food and drink, poetry and song
